Teri, please forward this to the HNRTC members.

I have attached a new version of the transmittal letter for the PAD based upon Jamie's comments. I do not wish to see the council get into a projected argument about this, however if we are going to paraphrase what the HNRTC finding says it is "The PAD finds that natural resource injury occurred or may be occurring at waste sites within the 1100 area". It does not say that the HNRTC determined that a Damage Assessment was not warranted. Based upon Barry Steins recommendation about this statement I think the letter could remain mute on what the HNRTC determined and let the authorized officials read the finding for themselves. Therefore we could eliminate the first sentence, second paragraph altogether and not have any reason to argue about what the council determined. I put 30 days in for response from the authorized officials because that appears to be the normal length of time listed throughout 43 CFR 11 for document review. This is a different situation then the normal damage assessment process but it should work. Please request response from the HNRTC within the original two week time frame.
