Dear Mr. Pasternak:

The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers (USACE), Walla Walla District, is beginning preparation of the final design report (contract plans and specifications) for remediation of Hanford's Horn Rapids Landfill (HRL) site. Remediation of this site will require placement of random fill and top soil as cover material over a 10.1 hectare (25 acre) area.

On April 16, 1993, you were notified in writing of the Corps desire to obtain permission for use of Pit-9 located on the Hanford Site. We still desire use of Pit-9 as the source for the random fill we need to remediate the HRL.

We are also in need of a source of fine grained material (top soil) to complete the HRL remediation. We have continued with our investigation for top soil in the vicinity of the landfill, with limited results. It is in the Government's interest that a government owned material source be made available for the Contractor's use, should a more economical private source not be identified.

Our investigation's have determined that McGee Ranch is a government owned site on the Hanford Site that can produce the type and quantity of material needed. McGee Ranch (Area A) is reported to have approximately 4.5 million cubic yards of fine grained soil. (Reference Document No. WHC-SD-EN-AP-051 dated January 1992).

The USACE Walla Walla District, by this letter, requests authorization to excavate and remove soil material from McGee Ranch located on the Hanford Reservation. A location map is enclosed. Access to, and material borrow from McGee Ranch will be required for about a 6 month period, beginning in September /October 1993.



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Soil material removed from the McGee Ranch will only be used for restoration of the Horn Rapids Landfill as part of the remediation of that site. About 14,000 m³ (18,000 yd³) of top soil will be needed.


