Re: Inspection of the 2727-WA 90-Day Dangerous Waste Accumulation Area and Equipment Storage Yard on July 18, 2007

Thank you for the assistance from U. S. Department of Energy – Office of River Protection and CH2M Hill Hanford Group (CH2M) staff during the Washington State Department of Ecology's recent inspection of the 2727-WA 90-day dangerous waste accumulation area operated by CH2M. No violations were found during this inspection, and all concerns have been addressed.

During the inspection, we discussed with CH2M staff how a list of active 90-day accumulation areas should be maintained in the operating record as required by the Hanford Facility RCRA Permit. We would like to reiterate that 90-day accumulation areas identified in the operating record should represent geographic locations, not portable waste containers themselves.
