Re: 325 Hazardous Waste Treatment Units Correction to Amendments for the Site Wide Permit

This letter is being issued to correct an error in Chapter 6, Amendment III.6.B.o. where an agreement was reached between the Washington State Department of Ecology (Ecology) and Pacific Northwest National Laboratories staff to submit Waste Analysis Plan (WAP) data for Ecology review within 90 days of issuance of the 325 Hazardous Waste Treatment Units permit. The timeframe for submitting WAP data was inadvertently changed from 90 days to 30 days. The amendment shall be corrected to read as follows:

“Within 90 days of the issuance of this Permit, the Permittees shall submit the following for review and approval by the Department: for each parameter, the respective accuracy, precision, and quantitation limit (or minimum detectable activity) necessary to meet the regulatory or decision limit. These data quality requirements shall be added to the Waste Analysis Plan and become enforceable conditions of the Permit. For determining the toxicity characteristics, SW-846 Method 1311 remains the required extraction method.”
