The Washington State Department of Ecology (Ecology) recently received the requests for exemption for demolition activities at 200 East Area (2707E, 2719E, 2713E, 2715E, and 2722E) and 600 Area (2905P and 2905R). After a thorough review of the proposed actions and associated estimates, Ecology has concluded that these demolition activities are exempt from new source review pursuant to Washington Administrative Code (WAC) 173-400-110(5).

Although the potential emission of airborne lead is not significant enough to affect public health, Ecology urges Fluor Hanford, Inc. to take proper protective measures for onsite workers.
