Thank you Teri for preparing the draft agenda. Lauri Vigue and I have the following suggested changes:

- 1) Consistent with Council decisions made in January agenda topics should address high-priority projects, e.g., 100 PAS, ERDF MAP. It would be helpful if we knew how topics link to priority projects. For example, the topic "DOE Standard 1153" could be changed to, "A Graded Approach for Evaluating Radiation Doses to Aquatic and Terrestrial Biota for Use in DOE Compliance and Risk Assessment Activities" - how it will be used in the 100 B/C Pilot Project.
- 2) Given there has been so much interest in the Ray Johnson presentation we suggest at least one hour. Ray could focus his presentation on 100 Area issues.
- 3) What is the objective for the presentation on the tritium plume; how can the trustees use this information?
- 4) Is there a decision to be made on the chrome integration report? What are the possible next steps? Having this information in advance may result in a more fruitful and decisive discussion.
- 5) The "Council Direction" topic on Thursday will include administrative decision-making, and CERCLA/NRDA integration. It will be lead by Tom Zeilman, with John Price talking about the integration.
- 6) Tom will also lead the 100 Area PAS discussion and the Funding Agreement topic. We look forward to hearing USDOE's initial response and consensus on how the Agreement can be modified for approval.

Hope this helps.
