


#### 4.2 INTERAGENCY MANAGEMENT INTEGRATION TEAM

The DOE, EPA and Ecology shall each designate a representative to act as a member of the Interagency Management Integration Team (IAMIT). The DOE representative shall be an Assistant Manager (in the instance of DOE's Richland Operat~~Office~~ the DOE has designated the Assistant Manager ~~Planning and Integrati~~ **Central Plateau** in the instance of DOE's Office of River Protection, DOE shall designate two (2) IAMIT members i.e. the ORP Assistant Manager for Waste Treatment and Immobilization Plant, and the ORP Assistant Manager for Tank Farms). The EPA representative shall be the Program Manager, Hanford Project Office. The Ecology representative shall be the Program Manager for the Nuclear Waste Program. The assigned representatives acting as members of the IAMIT shall be reasonably available in the ~~Cities~~ to perform the roles described in this section. Roles of the IAMIT or their designated representatives shall include the following responsibilities.
