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Comments requested on WRAP II

— Tri-Party Agreement Milestone Changes Proposed —

The Waste Retrieval and Processing Facility -- Module II (WRAP II) would not be built at the Hanford Site according to proposed changes to the Tri-Party Agreement.

Changes include:

- A contract with a commercial firm(s) would provide stabilization of low level mixed waste on a fixed-unit price basis.
- The strategy requires that waste be treated and/or disposed of at a rate that meets or exceeds treatment volumes that were planned for the original WRAP II facility.
- Treatment for three waste streams may not be required prior to direct disposal if these streams surpass treatment standards.
