Site Treatment Plans for Mixed Wastes

Wednesday • May 3, 1995 • 7:00-9:00 p.m.

The U.S. Department of Energy (DOE) must put in place by October 6, 1995, final plans for treating and storing mixed wastes generated at 48 different sites. Mixed wastes contain both radioactivity and hazardous chemicals.

The Federal Government generates and stores mixed wastes at two sites in Washington state: DOE's Hanford Site and the Puget Sound Naval Shipyard in Bremerton. In addition, the shipyard and 12 other sites propose sending certain mixed wastes to Hanford for treatment at an as yet to be built facility. It is proposed the treated wastes would be returned to their sites of origin for interim storage.

A public comment period is open until July 5, 1995
