


**Description of current waste site condition:**

The site is a construction dump site where burning occurred. Debris, including large concrete blocks, sandblast grit, and metal debris are scattered across the surface. Site 100-N-39 was originally (and mistakenly) mapped as being inside the BPA Substation fence line, but no dump is in that location and the reference documents describe the dump as being outside the fence. The descriptions inside the several references for 100-N-39 all describe the debris found at site 600-32.

**Basis for reclassification:**

This site is a duplicate of WIDS code 600-32, and is contained within a larger site, 100-N-19.
