Description/Justification of Change				
This change package extends the due date for the Final Determination M-91-03 Interim Milestone initial submittal of the revised Hanford Site TRU/TRUM and mixed low-level waste project management plan. Preparation of the TRU/TRUM PMP is dependent on the outcome of ongoing M91 discussions. The PMP will be due after the settlement is concluded allowing the PMP to align with the Parties requirements. The initial submittal of the revised PMP will not have a draft change request referenced or attached as an appendix to the PMP as the outcome of the M-91 Directors Determination and Administrative Order settlement will define waste program scope.
