CONTRACT NO. DE-AC06-93RL12367 – CONCURRENCE WITH THE 618-4 BURIAL  
GROUND DRUMMED WASTE TREATMENT DECISION

This is in response to your letter to me, same subject, dated October 25, 2000, requesting concurrence on the Bechtel Hanford, Inc. (BHI) decision to treat the drums in the 618-4 Burial Grounds using existing Hanford capability through the Fluor Hanford, Inc. (FHI) contract with Allied Technology Group.

The U.S. Department of Energy, Richland Operations Office (RL) staff met with BHI and FHI staff on December 21, 2000, to discuss potential issues and coordination between contractors. Based on those discussions, RL concurs with the BHI decision. It is expected that BHI will work closely with FHI and RL to coordinate treatment of the drums.

If, in my capacity as a Contracting Officer's Representative (COR), I provide any direction which your company believes exceeds my COR authority, you are to immediately notify the Contracting Officer and request clarification prior to complying with the direction.
