Reference: Letter 06-ED-0022, K. A. Klein to M. A. Wilson; "Request for Revision of Notice of Construction (NOC) Application and Approval Order DE 98NWP-003, and an Administrative Amendment to the Hanford Site Air Operating Permit (AOP) (Number 00-05-006) for the 305B Building Waste Management Activities," dated December 21, 2005

In the reference letter, the United States Department of Energy-Richland Operations (USDOE-RL) petitioned for the revision of the existing Notice of Construction (NOC) Approval Order DE-98NWP-003 gas cylinder management process housed within Building 305-B of the Hanford Site. The USDOE-RL petition revision request identified that no emissions or capacity changes have occurred, and the basis for revision is to relocate the process to Building 331-C, room 1, approximately 1.1 km southeast of Building 305-B.

USDOE-RL additionally requested administrative revision of the Hanford Site Air Operating Permit (AOP) to address this relocation. The Nuclear Waste Program treats this request as a change not requiring permit revision, under Washington Administrative Code (WAC) 173-401-722. The relocation of the process will be addressed in on-going AOP renewal.

This letter issues approval for the petitioned revision of the NOC as subject to regulation under Chapters 173-400 and 173-460, WAC, General Regulations for Air Pollution Sources and Controls for New Sources of Toxic Air Pollutants.

The following Order amendment changes are approved and ordered as Order No. DE-98NWP-003, Amendment 1.

Revise Approval Order Title as:

Revise location of process within Approval Order Conditions as:

Approval Condition 1.1: Gas cylinder residuals will be exhausted only through the
chemical fume hood of Building 331-C, room 1.

issuance of Order DE-98NWP-003, Approval Condition 9, Reporting, is corrected to:




