Summary of Discussion and Commitments/Agreements

1. **Approval of Past UMM Minutes (Ecology/RL/EPA/WHC):**

Meeting Minutes for the April 6, 1993, Unit Manager Meeting (UMM) were approved.

2. **Status Action Items:**

No action items.

3. **Status Closure Activities:**

The Nonradioactive Dangerous Waste Landfill (NRDWL) Closure/Postclosure Plan was transferred from the Lacey-Ecology office (R. Cordts) to the Kennewick-Ecology office (A. Rainey) at the April 1993 UMM. Ecology (A. Rainey) stated that supporting information from Lacey-Ecology is slowly coming into to his possession. Ecology (A. Rainey) will first determine if they have all of the documents necessary before beginning a review. RL/WHC provided a list of the documents (Attachment 4) that have been transmitted to the Lacey-Ecology office for A. Rainey's use in assuring that all documents from Lacey-Ecology have been received. RL/WHC will supply Ecology with copies of any missing documents, if necessary.

The soil gas sampling involving the gas chromatograph (GC) is expected to begin in late May to early June. This will allow for warmer weather and provide a chance for the soil column to equilibrate from placement of the initial soil gas probe effort. A report providing the results of the soil gas screening should be available to Ecology by the end of May 1993. This report will detail areas at the NRDWL where soil gas has been grossly detected; these areas will then be resampled using the more sensitive GC. Ecology (A. Rainey) will be notified at least 1 week prior to the commencement of the soil gas sampling utilizing the GC, by RL/WHC. A second GPR investigation (south of the J. A. Jones trench) was conducted to cover areas required by the soil gas sampling effort as stipulated in the Closure Plan and to assure that insertion of additional soil gas probes could be completed safely. A report containing all GPR investigations conducted should be available for Ecology by mid-June 1993.
