
The purpose of this letter is to submit the attached Supplemental Remedial

This draft work plan presents the sampling strategy and rationale for collecting supplemental
remedial investigation data for the Central Plateau soil operable unit waste sites identified during
a recently completed data quality objectives (DQO) development process conducted between RL
and the regulators. This DQO process focused on identification of additional data needs that
would lead to improved capability for the Tri-Party agencies to make final records of decision
for remediation of the Central Plateau soil waste site operable units.
