
This form documents agreement among the parties listed below authorizing classification of the subject unit as rejected, closed-out, or no action and authorizing backfill of the site, if appropriate. Final removal from the NPL of no action or closed-out sites will occur at a future date.

Description of current waste site condition:

HW-60807, written in 1959, states that area around the 291-A stack was radiologically posted in 1959 due to mixed fission product fallout from the 291-A Stack. The contaminated area was determined to not be the result of a single release, but from an accumulation of contamination spreads over time.

Basis for reclassification:

The release site is not separately marked or posted. This release occurred within the current boundaries of the 200-E-103 WIDS site. The area known as 200-E-103 was surface stabilized in 1999. Because it would be difficult to distinguish the release from the other of the contaminated soil in the area, it will be consolidated into 200-E-103. It is recommended this site be Reject (Consolidated) into 200-E-103. Cleanup activities will be addressed during disposition of the larger site, 200-E-103.
