Meeting Highlights

The purpose of the meeting was to propose a change of scope to the 1100-EM-1 Work Plan regarding air quality monitoring (paragraph 4.4.2.1, pages 4-62 to 4-67 of DOE-RL 88-23, "Remedial Investigation/Feasibility Study Work Plan for the 1100-EM-1 Operable Unit Hanford Site, Richland, Washington," August 1989). Evaluation of the air pathway for risk assessment requires additional data not foreseen when the work plan was written.

Permission was requested to modify the work plan so that air sampling may be conducted around more than one site in the Horn Rapids Landfill and under varying meteorological conditions.

A written request for modification of the work plan will be submitted per Section 9.3 of the Hanford Federal Agreement and Consent Order.
