Explanation of Significant Difference for the Environmental Restoration Disposal Facility

An Explanation of Significant Difference (ESD) is being issued for public review that describes changes to the Record of Decision for the Environmental Restoration Disposal Facility (ERDF). The ESD reaffirms that only waste generated during Hanford cleanup is eligible for disposal in the ERDF. It clarifies that these wastes include material coming from buildings, investigations, and many inactive liquid disposal areas. The ESD also modifies the handling option for liquids generated in the landfill. These liquids may be used to control dust in the landfill provided that they meet environmental limits. Public review begins June 3, 1996 and ends July 3, 1996.
