Engineering Evaluation/Cost Analysis for Disposal of Structural Concrete and Soil from the 183-H Solar Evaporation Basin

An Engineering Evaluation/Cost Analysis (EE/CA) is being issued for public review describing proposed removal actions for waste generated from closure activities of the 183-H Solar Evaporation Basin (located in the 100 Area of the Hanford site). The waste includes stockpiled low-level radiologically and chemically contaminated structural concrete and soils that will require disposal at a landfill designed to manage low level wastes. The preferred alternative, disposal at the Environmental Restoration Disposal Facility, removes potential for a release of hazardous substances. **Public review begins September 12, 1996 and ends October 11, 1996.**
