2003 NONCOMPLIANCE REPORT FOR SUBMITTAL TO THE STATE OF WASHINGTON, DEPARTMENT OF ECOLOGY, IN FULFILLMENT OF CONDITION I.E.19. OF THE HANFORD FACILITY RESOURCE CONSERVATION AND RECOVERY ACT PERMIT (WA7890008967)

There are no noncompliances to report for Calendar Year 2003. This letter serves as the 2003 Noncompliance Report submitted in fulfillment of Condition I.E.19 of the Dangerous Waste Portion of the Hanford Facility Resource Conservation and Recovery Act Permit. This condition states, "The permittees shall report to the Department all instances of noncompliance not otherwise required to be reported elsewhere in this Permit at the time the Annual Dangerous Waste Report is submitted." Additionally, noncompliances with the permit conditions alleged by Ecology or reported by the permittees through Notices of Violation, Notices of Correction, Inspection Reports, Project Manager Meeting Minutes, or other written correspondence are excluded. The due date for the Annual Dangerous Waste Report, to be submitted to the State of Washington Department of Ecology under separate cover, is March 1, 2004.


