Re: Categorical State Waste Permit Application for Use on the Hanford Site

Enclosed is a form developed by the Washington State Department of Ecology (Ecology) titled *Categorical State Waste Discharge Permit Application for Industrial Discharges to Land - Hanford Specific* (ECY 040-177 [3/95]). This form is to be used by the U.S. Department of Energy (USDOE), Richland Operations Office, when submitting state waste discharge permit applications for the four types of "categorical" discharges defined in the *Plan and Schedule for Disposition and Regulatory Compliance for Miscellaneous Streams* (DOE-RL-93-94, Revision 1) (Plan and Schedule). Ecology modified the permit application format to eliminate requirements for information not needed for categorical permit preparation.

The Plan and Schedule defines the timetable for completing activities resulting in the regulatory compliance of all Hanford Site Miscellaneous Streams, as required by Consent Order No. DE 91NM-177. Some of the scheduled dates for submittals were described in terms such as "60 days after approval of the Plan and Schedule." In a meeting with the USDOE permitting staff, submittal dates were agreed upon for the Plan and Schedule activities as follows:

- Activity 6-1.1: Identify streams requiring selection of BMP (Best Management Practice) - 05/09/95;
- Activity 6-1.2: Submit the BMP options, the preferred selection, and implementation schedule to Ecology for approval - 08/09/96;
- Activity 6-1.3: Receive a response from Ecology approving or not approving the BMP preferred selection - 09/25/96;



- Activity 6-2.1: Register Class V injection wells with Ecology - 08/09/95;
- Activity 6-2.2: Issue and annually update the Miscellaneous Streams inventory - 09/30 each year through 1998;
- Activity 6-2.3: File one categorical WAC 173-216 permit application - 11/30/95.

The dates selected were based on Ecology's approval date for the Plan and Schedule of February 9, 1995. The other activities listed in the Plan and Schedule shall be submitted on the dates listed in the Plan and Schedule.
