



EXTENSION AT THE INTERAGENCY MANAGEMENT INTEGRATION TEAM (IAMIT) LEVEL FOR THE HANFORD FEDERAL FACILITY AGREEMENT AND CONSENT ORDER (TRI-PARTY AGREEMENT) DENIAL OF THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF ENERGY – OFFICE OF RIVER PROTECTION REQUEST FOR WAIVER TO HANFORD FEDERAL FACILITY AGREEMENT AND CONSENT ORDER WASTE RETRIEVAL CRITERIA FOR SINGLE-SHELL TANK 241-C-106

The U.S. Department of Energy, Office of River Protection (DOE-ORP) invoked the Tri-Party Agreement dispute resolution process with the Washington State Department of Ecology (Ecology) under Hanford Federal Facility and Consent Order (HFFACO) Article VIII, Resolution of Disputes, Paragraph 30 at the IAMIT level on March 21, 2019 (Administrative Record Accession Number AR-01075). On April 2, 2019, the parties signed an extension to May 13, 2019 to continue trying to resolve the dispute at the IAMIT level. On May 8, 2019, the IAMIT agreed to continue trying to resolve the dispute until June 12, 2019.

The Parties hereby agree to extend the period of dispute resolution at the IAMIT level until June 12, 2019. The Parties jointly determined that this extension is desirable to provide them additional time to reach resolution regarding the path forward for the waste retrieval criteria for Single-Shell Tank 241-C-106.
