The U.S. Department of Energy, Richland Operations Office began a 45-day public comment period on April 11 on the revised draft of the HSW EIS. This revised draft will evaluate impacts associated with the disposal of immobilized low-activity waste from the Hanford tank waste processing along with environmental impacts associated with ongoing activities of the Hanford Site Solid Waste Program. The revised draft will contain analyses of additional alternatives for managing wastes (low-level, mixed low-level, and transuranic waste) generated at Hanford and received from other U.S. Department of Energy (DOE) sites.

A series of regional public meetings will begin this Thursday, May 1 at the Red Lion Hanford House at 802 George Washington Way in Richland. The meetings will begin with an opportunity for informal dialogue with the EIS Document Manager, Michael Collins, followed by the meeting at 7:00 p.m. You are encouraged to attend the meeting to learn more about this important EIS and provide comments.

DOE will hold other meetings in Spokane and Seattle, Washington, and LaGrande, Portland, and Hood River, Oregon. The meeting schedule is:
