







**ADMINISTRATIVE ISSUES**

Changes were made to the minutes from the October meeting and there were no comments to the November minutes. Both minutes were approved and signed.

Rick Bond was asked about the April 18, 2000, PFP TPA/RCRA issues meeting minute's approval. He stated that issues from the meeting minutes from April 18, 2000, continue to be under review and would not be signed until Laura Ruud (Ecology) was present. It was decided that the original (7) April 18, 2000, attendees would meet to discuss the meeting minutes in early January 2001. Rob Piippo took the action to schedule the meeting.

**PFP PROJECT OVERVIEW STATUS - Larry Fitch**

Larry Fitch provided status on the PFP safety performance and also the current status of residues, thermal stabilization, solutions stabilization, and the bagless transfer system. A handout titled "Current PFP Status" was passed out to meeting participants. PFP has gone one year without lost time injuries and they are to receive a safety award.

Thermal stabilization is running smoothly. In FY 1999, 150 items have been stabilized, FY 2000, 578 oxide and seven metal items have been stabilized and in FY 2001, 15 metal items have been stabilized, with a total of 750. Solutions stabilization is running behind schedule. It should be completed in 2001. The residues packaging should be completed by April 2004. Currently they are running behind schedule. There is a lot of management attention on this. Discussion has been done on whether to submit a change request stating they will not be able to make the April scheduled date. The Bagless Transfer System is on schedule.

**HANFORD ASH REPACKAGING TPA NEGOTIATIONS STATUS – Jon Yerxa**

### **MYWP PROCESS STATUS – Larry Fitch**

PFM has an approved MYWP with a few changes having been made but nothing substantial. Money was moved around and extended some schedules. Hanford Ash is on the top of the unfunded list. Working to get it put on the funded list.

### **TANK Z 361 BCR/TPA STATUS – Keith Hampton**

A change request was approved for FY 2001 to complete tank characterization report. It is to be completed by July 2001. The budget through FY 2005 is in a PFM Baseline Change Request. The key activities to be funded are to complete TCR by 9/2001, complete Applicable or Relevant and Appropriate Requirements by 9/2002, complete EE/CA by 9/2003, and to complete draft design by 9/2005.

### **JUSTIFICATION FOR DECISION TO NOT HAVE PUBLIC COMMENT ON ROCKY FLATS TPA CHANGE REQUEST – Jon Yerxa**

The schedule to implement the TPA CR was not conducive to going out for public comment. The CR was minor in scope and both Parties agreed that the major transition TPA change request package will go out for public comment.
