


Dear Rose,

Thank you for your May 1, 2018 letter summarizing the Yakama Nation's positions on the proposed remedial actions for the Hanford 100 D/H Area. Groundwater monitoring and pump and treat system data will continue to be made available to the Yakama Nation ERWM Program, including at the bi-monthly Unit Manager meetings and through the relevant DOE annual reports.

We've spoken with DOE and DOE is prepared to provide information on implementation of the institutional controls component of the remedy, through publication of its annual institutional controls assessment reports available in the TPA Administrative Record. DOE is also committed to continue to work with the Yakama Nation on NHPA and any needed mitigation in implementing the remedy. To this end, we invite the Yakama Nation to discuss its remaining NHPA concerns with EPA and DOE.

Please don't hesitate to contact me or my staff with any questions or concerns. We are also prepared to meet with you and your staff as needed to address questions or concerns.
