ACCELERATING CLEANUP: FOCUS ON 2006, RELEASED FOR PUBLIC REVIEW AND COMMENT

On June 12, 1997, Discussion Drafts of the National and Site Specific 2006 Plans titled, "Accelerating Cleanup: Focus on 2006" were released for public review and comment. Copies of the National Discussion Draft are being transmitted under separate cover by the U.S. Department of Energy, Headquarters. Copies of the U.S. Department of Energy, Richland Operations Office's (RL) Discussion Drafts, are being directly mailed to Tribal Nations, stakeholders, regulators, and elected officials. In addition, copies of these documents have been hand delivered to key points of contact of these groups.

The RL Discussion Draft consists of an Executive Summary, Narrative, and Project Baseline Summaries. The Executive Summary provides a 13-page synopsis of the Site Specific Plan for interested individuals. The Narrative provides an 115-page explanation of the Plan and is intended for the individual or group who requires additional detail. The Project Baseline Summaries are quite extensive (approximately eight inches of 11" by 17" spreadsheets) and provide project-by-project detail and are intended for the group or individual who requires in-depth details of the individual projects at Hanford.


