Description of Change:
 The Surveillance and Maintenance Plan for 105-N/109-N (DOE/RL-2011-106) does not provide for an area around the reactor to be laid bare of vegetation to allow a firebreak in Section 5.4. This change provides additional clarification


Rudy Guercia and Rick Bond , Ecology agree that the proposed change **DOE** **Lead Regulatory Agency** modifies an approved workplan/document and will be processed in accordance with the Tri-Party Agreement Action Plan, Section 9.0, *Documentation and Records*, and not Chapter 12.0, *Changes to the Agreement*.

The following updated language is to be added to Section 5.4 of the Surveillance and Maintenance Plan:

- In section 5.4, a second paragraph will be added which reads: "The area around the 105N/109N shall be maintained in a state devoid of vegetation such that it acts as a fire break. The area around the cocooned reactor will not be revegetated similar to what is done at surrounding waste sites. Should any vegetation grow in the immediate area around the base of the 105N/109N reactor, herbicide applications will be applied to the area, as necessary, to keep the area clear of vegetation. A vegetation-free area of 25 feet (minimum) shall be established around 105N/109N"

Justification and Impacts of Change:
 This change provides clarification that the area around the reactor does not require revegetation similar to that of the surrounding waste sites due to the need to keep plant growth away from the reactor structure. This supports use of the clear area as a fire break
