



**Description of Change:**

Leach tests at location 100-C-7 will not be conducted under this scope of work. This change affects Table ES-1 and 4-4, and pages 4-12, 4-22 and 4-23 of the Work Plan. The change also affects DOE/RL-2009-44, *Sampling and Analysis Plan for the 100-BC-1, 100-BC-2, and 100-BC-5 Operable Units Remedial Investigation/Feasibility Study, Rev. 0*, which will be addressed under a separate Change Notice (TPA-CN-351).

Briant Charboneau and Laura Buelow agree that the proposed change  
**DOE** **Lead Regulatory Agency**  
 modifies an approved work plan/document and will be processed in accordance with the Tri-Party Agreement Action Plan, Section 9.0, *Documentation and Records*, and not Chapter 12.0, *Changes to the Agreement*.

**Justification and Impacts of Change:**

These changes remove collection and analysis of a sample from location 100-C-7. It was concluded during meetings with DOE and EPA that numerous chromium batch leach samples from borings within the 100-BC area will be collected; so, a specific sample does not need to be planned from 100-C-7. During verification sampling (under scope of a different document), enough sample material will be collected to run a batch leach test if determined it is desired. This change makes the work plan consistent with the associated Sampling and Analysis Plan as changed under TPA-CN-351.
