I have reviewed this document. I have the following comments:

Section 2.1.2 - This section is an admission that this report is incomplete. Those non-conforming items which are the subject of engineering studies should be a part of this plan. Those items that are under construction should be listed as such and a completion schedule submitted for the record. Those whose status is simply being coordinated should be either put under construction or included as part of this plan.

The tanks in the 236-Z Building should be ultrasonically tested if at all possible. Either test them in this fashion, or provide justification to demonstrate the impossibility of doing so.
