The subgroup of the Hanford Natural Resource Trustees met to discuss its review of the 1100 Area Record of Decision (ROD). The goal of the group is to produce a unified report on the ROD to be issued by the Trustees to the Tri-Parties.

An interim step in the group review is a presentation of its work in progress to the rest of the trustees at their next meeting. The presentation was organized and the work delegated as follows:

Description of 1100 Area -- M. Bauer, C. Burford, and J. Hall

Contamination and Proposed Actions -- S. Harris, D. Conrad

Issues and Concerns -- S. Cross, G. Tallent, and K. Leonard

## A preliminary list of issues and concerns include:

Is the 1100 Area Environmental Assessment suitable for use in lieu of a preassessment screen?

How should the ROD address restoration, rather than just remediation?

How should the ROD address baseline conditions?

How should the ROD address defenses to natural resource injury liability?

How should the ROD address land use; for example, the inconsistency between the site development plan and the capping of the Horn Rapids Landfill?

How should the ROD address the potential liability of Siemens Power Corp. for the groundwater contamination?

Was the ROD based on site-specific resource surveys?

Are off-site remedial impacts of concern to the Trustees?

This subgroup plans to meet in Richland on April 29, 1994. The group decided that they should tour the 1100 Area and get a basic understanding of the sites in question. The group decided the tour would most likely be from 8:00 to 11:00. After the site tour, the group will meet and discuss their work-in-progress (11:00 - 3:00). Ecology representatives will attend the afternoon session by telephone or video conferencing.

Other actions:

Kathleen Leonard will look for aerial photographs of the 1100 Area

Kathleen Leonard will try to provide material data safety sheets

Kathleen Leonard will organize the April 29th meeting
