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This form documents agreement among the parties listed below authorizing classification of the subject unit as rejected, closed out, or no action and authorizing backfill of the site, if appropriate. Final removal from the NPL of no action or closed-out sites will occur at a future date.

**Description of current waste site condition:**

The North Process Pond is currently posted as a soil contamination area (SCA) pending authorization to backfill and recontour the site.

**Basis for reclassification:**

Remediation of the North Process Pond (316-2), including the Scraping Disposal Area (618-12), was completed in accordance with the 300-FF-1 Remedial Design Report/Remedial Action Work Plan (RDR/RAWP)(DOE/RL-96-70). Contaminated soil and debris were excavated from the pond areas and transported to the ERDF for disposal. During the excavation process, 5 unplanned releases to the North Process Pond were also remediated, including UPR-300-7. The other 4 unplanned releases (UPR-300-34, UPR-300-35, UPR-300-36, and UPR-300-37) are associated with both the North Process Pond and South Process Pond (316-1), and will be closed out when remediation of the South Process Pond is complete. Remaining soil in the North Process Pond (including the Scraping Disposal Area) was sampled, analyzed, and found to be below cleanup standards as documented in the 300-FF-1 Operable Unit, North Process Pond/Scraping Disposal Area Verification Package (BHI-01298). The North Process Pond and Scraping Disposal Area is therefore verified to be remediated and to no longer pose an unacceptable threat to human health or the environment in an industrial setting.
