

### **242-A EVAPORATOR**

- Maintenance and pre-start items being worked
- Cold run and Evaporator Campaign 2002-01 scheduled to begin March 15

### **LIQUID EFFLUENT RETENTION FACILITY (LERF)**

#### **Waste Inventory (2/21/02)**

- Basin 42 - Liquid Level: 2.8 ft or 0.5 Mgal
- Basin 43 - Liquid Level: 15.8 ft or 4.5 Mgal (Receiving groundwater at 53 gpm)
- Basin 44 - Liquid Level: 16.9 ft or 5.0 Mgal

#### **Wastes received in LERF during January:**

- Basin 42 received 500 gallons by tanker from HEHF
- Basin 42 received 38,000 gallons by tanker from 105-H Fuel Storage Basin
- Basin 42 received 7200 gallons by tanker from the Mixed Waste Burial Trench
- ETF Surge tank received 4,000 gallons by tanker from 105-H Fuel Storage Basin

### **200 AREA EFFLUENT TREATMENT FACILITY (ETF)**

- RCRA campaign completed
- Shipped 80 drums powder waste to ERDF
- Completed hydro test and DOT re-certification of one tanker

### **200 AREA TREATED EFFLUENT DISPOSAL FACILITY (TEDF)**

- Total discharge: 2.4 Mgal
- Average monthly flow: 53 gpm
- Minimum daily flow: 2 gpm
- Maximum daily flow: 228 gpm

- III. Project Specific Issues
  - A. Delisting Petition Discussion
    - 1. Grant Baston (DOE-RL) reported that the petition has been submitted to Dave Bartus (EPA) for review. However, Mr Bartus is running approximately 10 weeks behind schedule.
  - B. LERF Groundwater Discussion
    - 1. Fred Jamison reported that Ecology is strategizing to formulate a response to the groundwater issue and are waiting to respond the letter. Paul Crane (FH) volunteered to set up a meeting with RL and Ecology to resolve outstanding issues.
  - C. PCB Path Forward
    - 1. Grant Baston stated that RL was ready to transmit the letter to EPA for review.
  - D. Status of Permit Revisions
    - 1. Roger Szelmeczka (FH) reported that the annual update to drawings will be included in the next quarterly modification submittal package.
  - E. RCRA Permit Noncompliance
    - 1. No noncompliances to report.
- IV. General Discussions
  - A. No further discussions to report.
- V. Status of Actions
  - A. LWFP-00-018 (709) – action remains open. On 1/24/02 RL transmitted the proposed plan to Ecology. Ecology rejected part of the plan.
  - B. LWFP-01-024 (757) – action was closed.
  - C. 810 – action remains open.
- VI. New Action Items
  - A. Dave Bartus was assigned an action to provide a revised schedule for the Delisting Petition commitments.
- VII. Next Project Managers Meeting
  - A. The next project meeting is scheduled for March 28, 2002.
