Summary of Discussion and Commitments/Agreements

1. Approval of Past UMM Minutes

The November 16, 1993, Unit Managers' Meeting Minutes were reviewed and signed by the Unit Managers.

2. Status Action Items:

-No Open Action Items

There was no discussion.

3. Status Closure Activities:

-Status NOD Comments (On Schedule)

WHC (D. M. Korematsu-Olund) stated that WHC and RL would like agreement from Ecology, that the final waste inventory detonated at the 218 E-8 Borrow Demolition Pit, consisted of 4 chemicals (2-butoxyethanol, 1-4 dioxane, isopropyl ether, and methyl ethyl ketone peroxide) and that these chemicals were the only known chemicals detonated at the demolition site. RL would like Ecology to concur that WHC will look at only the afore mentioned four chemical inventory and/or their degradation by-products as a basis to evaluate the sampling plan. WHC will also sample for unused initiating detonation material. General site sampling issues that pertain to the Demolition sites (Ash Pit, and 218 E-8) should be covered by a Data Quality Objectives (DQO) meeting. Ecology (F. Ma) agreed with the corrections to the waste inventory as written and accepted the final chemical list. However, Ecology expressed concern about the sampling plan requesting review (of potential degradation products) by an Ecology chemist. WHC (D. M. Korematsu-Olund) affirmed that it would be fine to evaluate the degradation products of these chemicals through the DQO process.

WHC (D. M. Korematsu-Olund) requested Ecology's concurrence with the accuracy and completeness of the Ash Pit's chemical waste inventory. Ecology (F. Ma) agreed that the Ash Pit chemical inventory was acceptable.

WHC (D. M. Korematsu-Olund) requested that an Issue Resolution meeting for the 218-E-8 and the Ash Pit Demolition site NOD comments be set up to discuss issues other than those resolved through the DQO meetings. Ecology (F. Ma) requested that those questions that pertained to the DQO process be separated from other issues and those questions identified for discussion. RL (R. N. Krekel) stated that the issue resolution meeting can be the first week in January, to discuss non-DQO NOD questions. Ecology (F. Ma) confirmed that the Ecology conference room would be available for the issue resolution meeting on January 7, 1994.
