The U.S. Department of Energy (USDOE) is preparing an Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) for the removal of spent nuclear fuel from the Hanford K Basins, stabilization of the fuel, and storage of the fuel for a period of up to 40 years. USDOE proposes to place the fuel in a storage facility at the Hanford Site. USDOE believes that expeditious removal and storage of K Basins spent nuclear fuel away from the Columbia River is needed to reduce risks to public health and the environment.

USDOE is conducting public meetings on the scope of the EIS. You are encouraged to provide comments on the proposed scope and alternatives to be evaluated.
