I. Approval of April 24, 2008 WRAP Project Meeting Minutes (Ecology/DOE-RL/FH). The PMM minutes were approved.

III. Project Specific Issues

A. Permit Status

Joel Williams (FH) provided Ecology a proposed schedule for the SEPA checklist revision. Tanya Williams (Ecology) reported that the WRAP and CWC SEPA checklists are being updated, and requested expediting the schedule. Mr. Williams responded that FH's SEPA person is not available for two weeks. Mr. Williams suggested including T Plant with the CWC and WRAP SEPA checklist.

- B. Eric Van Mason (Ecology) stated that he is addressing EPA's comments on the Part B permit, and that the WRAP and CWC Part B should be ready for submittal to RL/FH for review by the middle of June 2008. Tony Miskho (FH) noted that PNNL relayed four significant issues associated with the waste analysis plan (WAP) which were raised through EPA's review. One issue was justifying or questioning the volume attached to waste codes in the Part A. Deborah Singleton (Ecology) responded that Ecology is working with EPA to address issues and comments that are raised by EPA on the WAP. Brian Dixon (FH) stated that RL/FH need to be apprised of any changes that affect their process in finalizing the Part B.

IV. General Discussions

- A. Deborah Singleton (Ecology) inquired about discussions regarding the possibility of an early closure date for WRAP in 2013. Greg Sinton (RL) stated that there have been discussions regarding WRAP's future. Mr. Sinton noted that WRAP is the only facility with certified WIPP shipping capabilities, and that the PMP still states a closure date of 2032.
- B. Mr. Williams acknowledged receipt of Ecology's questions regarding the SEPA checklist, which will be addressed by Mike Jansky (FH).

V. Status of Actions

- A. 1961 - Mr. Williams provided Ecology with a proposed schedule to prepare SEPA checklist revisions.
