Summary of Discussion and Commitments/Agreements

1. Discussion of Actions Required to Close 3718-F Facility

Attachment 3 included in these minutes provides a summary of the proposed actions that will result in the clean closure of the 3718-F Alkali Metal Treatment and Storage Facility. The proposed actions for each component of the facility were discussed. Concurrence was reached on all proposed actions.

2. Schedule for Completion and Submittal of the Closure Plan

A schedule for the completion of the closure plan was discussed. It was agreed that every effort will be made to transmit the closure plan to Ecology by the end of November. To satisfy this need, the following target dates have been identified for completion of key activities:

WHC to complete the final draft by:	11/10/95
WHC and DOE-RL will complete a concurrent review by:	11/16/95
WHC will incorporate all review comments and transmit	
the closure work plan to DOE-RL by:	11/21/95
DOE-RL will transmit the closure work plan to Ecology by:	11/28/95

The SEPA checklist has been revised and will be transmitted to Ecology as part of the closure work plan.

Schedule for Future Meetings

It was agreed that during the month of November, there appeared to be little need for a Unit Manager's Meeting. The month of November will be devoted to revising the closure work plan and submitting the plan to Ecology for their review. No cleanup work at the 3718-F Facility is scheduled during November. It was agreed that if a need should arise, that any Unit Manager has the authority to call a meeting during the month of November. The Unit Manager will call Jack Sonnichsen and he will provide the arrangements for this meeting.

It was agreed that the December Unit Managers Meeting will be held following the Christmas Holidays. To accommodate scheduled vacations, it was agreed that Thursday, January 11, 1996 would be targeted for the next Unit Managers Meeting. Jack Sonnichsen took the action to schedule the next Unit Managers Meeting.

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Jack Sonnichsen reported that the services of Mr. Douglas J. Vaught had been retained to function as the Professional Engineer that will certify the closure of the 3718-F Facility. No new business was identified and the meeting was adjourned at 3 pm.
