Summary of Discussion and Commitments/Agreements

1. STATUS OF PERMIT APPLICATION

Mr. J. Coenenberg (WHC) stated that revision of the LERF Part B permit application is on hold due to efforts to combine LERF with the 200 ETF and 242-A Evaporator Part B permit applications. WHC is reviewing Ecology's notice of deficiency (NOD) comments associated with the 200 ETF and 242-A Evaporator Part B permit applications. The NOD workshops with RL/WHC, Ecology and EPA are scheduled to begin in February 1995.

2. PROGRAM STATUS

Mr. B. Von Bargaen (WHC) reported that the operational test procedure (OTP) on leak testing Basin 44 was completed, and now the line from Basin 43 needs to be tied back in to Basin 44. The line was isolated during the last test run because of a leak. Mr. M. Jaraysi (Ecology) advised RL/WHC to notify Ecology and EPA that the leak testing was passed, and that WHC would like to establish the original plan of two basins with one basin contingency. Mr. Von Bargaen stated that WHC plans to leave Basin 44 as a contingency; and if Basin 43 is filled, then Basin 42 will be used as a contingency. Mr. M. Bowman (WHC) took the action to draft a letter to Ecology and EPA regarding the leak testing. Mr. Von Bargaen stated that the OTP should be completed and approved before WHC states that one volume contingency is available.

Mr. Coenenberg asked for clarification regarding the contingency basis volume, stating his understanding was that one basin contingency volume could include partial volume in two basins. Mr. Jaraysi concurred. Mr. Jaraysi inquired about the percentage of volume in the basins. Mr. Von Bargaen responded that Basin 43 is approximately 40 to 45 percent full, and Basins 42 and 44 contain heel volumes.

Mr. A. Stone (Ecology) inquired about the sampling. Mr. Von Bargaen stated that the sampling analysis forms have been issued. WHC is planning to initiate sampling in September 1994, and to complete the sampling before the October 9, 1994 due date.

3. **GENERAL DISCUSSION**

There were no topics for general discussion.

4. **ACTION ITEMS**

There were no past action items to status. There was one new action item for WHC to draft a letter to Ecology and EPA that leak testing on Basin 44 was passed, and that WHC will return to the original plan of two basins with one basin contingency volume.
