This letter follows my receipt of USDOEs' March 30, 1995 letter¹ to Doug Sherwood and I transmitting (revised) TPA change request M-43-95-01. After consideration of this matter (and discussion with Ecology, EPA, and "RL" staff) I have determined that Ecology can not approve this request in that its structure provides little assurance that work under this milestone would be effectively driven. Consequently, I have disapproved the subject change request, and am forwarding original documentation to Mr. Wisness through EPA (see also earlier telefaxed copies of this disapproval). This determination has been made pursuant to Dispute Resolution provisions of the TPA (Article VIII, paragraph 30). 41051


Consistent with the terms of the TPA (e.g., Article VII), USDOE remains bound by the conditions of current TPA milestone M-43-00 (and its associated interim milestones) and must take all actions necessary to maintain compliance. Please let me know if you would like to discuss this matter further. Ecology continues to support the concept of ensuring integrated management of tank farm upgrades, including doing so in part through project consolidation.
