
This form documents agreement among the parties listed below authorizing classification of the subject unit as rejected, closed-out, or no action and authorizing backfill of the site, if appropriate. Final removal from the NPL of no action or closed-out sites will occur at a future date.

Description of current waste site condition:

Ground contamination from an unknown source was detected around the cribs, south of PUREX, near the railroad tunnel (218-E-14). An Unplanned Release number was requested for this area on September 8, 1980. In 1981, Harold Maxfield stated the surface contamination was apparently removed in 1980 and the zone released when the double-exclusion fence was built around the 202-A Building. The Unplanned Release site was not marked or posted in 1981.

Basis for reclassification:

The location of this sites is within the boundaries of the surface stabilized area known as 200-E-103. It is recommended this release will be reclassified to Reject (Consolidated) into the 200-E-103 site. Cleanup activities will be addressed during disposition of the larger site, 200-E-103.
