



- I. Approval of the April 1, 2003 Liquid Processing and Canister Storage Project Meeting Minutes Ecology/DOE-RL/FH)
- A. A discussion of Keith Klein's new signature requirements was held to determine the process for obtaining the appropriate approvals. Jeannette Hyatt (FH) suggested adding a disclaimer to the minute's signature page to reflect concurrence on content, not as an agreement to commitments.
- II. Operational Status (Roger Szelmeczka FH)
- 242-A EVAPORATOR
- Evaporator is in Repair mode
 - Continuing with IX column piping and valve removal

LIQUID EFFLUENT RETENTION FACILITY (LERF)

Waste Inventory (5/7/3)

- Basin 42 - Liquid Level: 9.0 ft or 2.1 Mgal
- Basin 43 - Liquid Level: 13.0 ft or 3.4 Mgal (Receiving UP-1 groundwater at 44 gpm)
- Basin 44 - Liquid Level: 17.1 ft or 5.1 Mgal

Received 11 tanker shipments during April:

- Basin 42 received 50,000 gallons leachate from the Mixed Waste Burial Trench
- Basin 44 received 16,000 gallons by tanker from 105-KW Basin

EFFLUENT TREATMENT FACILITY (ETF)

- ETF processing Basin 43

200 AREA TREATED EFFLUENT DISPOSAL FACILITY (TEDF)

April monthly flow summary:

- Total discharge: 14.3 Mgal
- Average monthly flow: 48 gpm
- Minimum daily flow: 7.2 gpm
- Maximum daily flow: 200 gpm

300 AREA TREATED EFFLUENT DISPOSAL FACILITY (310 TEDF)

- TEDF continues in normal operations.

- III. Project Specific Issues
 - A. Delisting Petition
 - 1. Due to recent changes in site contact personnel, FH and Ecology are reviewing the process for communicating with Dave Bartus (EPA). EPA has addressed and incorporated the comments received to date. All comments have been addressed and incorporated. Jeannette Hyatt (FH) reported that FH can support EPA's word processing needs.
 - B. LERF Groundwater
 - 1. Fred Jamison (Ecology) reported that transmittal of the permit conditions is pending.
 - C. PCB Path Forward
 - 1. Mr. Szelmeczka, Ms. Mattlin, and Mr. Bartus have been meeting weekly on the RBDA and are evaluating re-issuing the document with the evaporator removed due to K Basins and other waste streams.. Approval is pending for CHG's assumption of evaporator operations. Mr. Bartus has extended the approval for the next evaporator campaign.
 - D. Permit Revisions Status
 - 1. The next quarterly submittal is pending approval at Ecology and includes the integrity assessment.
 - E. 242A Upgrades
 - 1. An ion exchange column was removed and issues are being worked to clear out as much waste as possible before the evaporator's transfer.
 - 2. Approval is pending for CHG's assumption of evaporator operations.
- IV. General Discussions
 - A. Roger Szelmeczka reported that after the evaporator transfer he will refocus on 310/340 issues. Since the facility no longer manages waste he will be preparing an inspection plan and will work to reduce maintenance and inspection activities.
- V. Status of Actions
 - A. 709 – no change in status.
 - B. 810 – discussions continue. More discussion will be needed.
 - C. 823 – the milestone change was completed. Action was closed.
- VI. New Action Items
 - A. No new action items to report.
- VII. Next Project Managers Meeting
 - A. The next Project Managers meeting is scheduled for June 19, 2003
