I. MODIFICATION

In accordance with Section 1.V, Page 3, of the above-referenced Consent Order, the parties agree to a modification which will revise a portion of the following section:

1. Revise section 4: 200 Area Treated Effluent Disposal Facility - Project W-049H, Table 2, 200E Laundry (new)

The start construction date of 2//93 shall be deleted.

2. The parties also agree to complete negotiations, by July 15, 1993, for deletion or modification of the remaining milestones for the new decontamination laundry facility as provided in Section 8: Interim Operating Restrictions and Impact Assessments, Table 6, New Decontamination Laundry Facility/B Pond System. The date for completion of negotiations may be extended if agreeable to both parties.

All other terms and conditions contained in the Consent Order remain in full force and effect.
