HANFORD C FARM LEAK ASSESSMENTS

Reference: Ecology letter from J. J. Lyon to S. J. Olinger, ORP, "Department of Ecology Concurrence with *Process to Assess Tank Farm Leaks in Support of Retrieval and Closure Planning*, RPP-32681, Revision 0," dated March 21, 2008.

Thank you for your concurrence on the Reference. Please note the "Hanford C Farm Leak Assessments Report: 241-C-101 and 241-C-110" (RPP-ENV-33418, Revision 0) was revised following completion of C-Farm leak assessments and issued as "Hanford C Farm Leak Assessments Report: 241-C-101, 241-C-110, 241-C-111, 241-C-105, and Unplanned Waste Releases" (RPP-ENV-33418, Revision 1). This document is available at http://www.hanfordcleanup.info/vadose_zone.html.

Regarding your request for an assessment of Tank 241-C-105, the U.S. Department of Energy, Office of River Protection (ORP), and the CH2M HILL Hanford Group, Inc. will conduct an assessment in accordance with Tank Farm Contractor procedures to reexamine the leak status Tank 241-C-105. Similar assessments will also be conducted for Tanks 241-C-110 and 241-C-111. Following the completion of these assessments, the Waste Tank Summary Report (HNF-EP-0182) will be revised to reflect the results of the assessments as well as the tank leak discharge volumes reported in RPP-ENV-33418. The Waste Information Data System (WIDS) will be updated, as needed, to include data on unplanned releases reported in RPP-ENV-33418.

ORP expects to complete the tank leak status assessments, the HNF-EP-0182 update, and the WIDS updates by September 30, 2008.


