

Attachment #1

Summary of Discussion

Unit Managers Meeting: 242-A Evaporator

May 21, 1992

Status of Ecology Review

Scott McKinney (Ecology) will be assisting Ecology's unit manager (Bob King). Because of recent changes in the duties of Mr. McKinney, it was uncertain when review of the 242-A Evaporator permit application would be complete. Ecology should be able within a few days to give RL an idea when the Notice of Deficiency (NOD) comments will be available.

ACTION ITEM: Ecology will inform RL (Cliff Clark) of the expected date for arrival of NOD comments on 242-A Evaporator. Action: Scott McKinney.

Two of Ecology's concerns for air emissions were discussed:

1) Ecology stated that the 242-A Evaporator application gives a limit of 3.1 tons per year for organics air emissions, but subpart AA would require that the limit applies to the entire Hanford facility. Ecology stated that, according to the guidance document for subpart AA, all of a facility's process vents covered under subpart AA must be identified by the facility's owner or operator. RL stated that Hanford does not have any real concentrated organics air streams, and even the level of organics levels from 242-A Evaporator will be low. RL stated that RL/WHC will review the issue of how subpart AA applies to 242-A Evaporator in conjunction with reviewing the unit's NOD comments.

2) Ecology is interested in the possible use of a closed loop for the cooling water to the main condenser in order to reduce waste water and air emissions. RL stated that a closed loop would likely require the use of cooling towers, and that cooling towers would have disadvantages, including blowdown from the towers and possible increased air emissions. WHC is already evaluating the closed-loop alternative and other issues in a report being prepared on 242-A Evaporator. There was general agreement that further discussion of a closed-loop system should await the results of WHC's report. Ecology (B. King) expressed interest in receiving a draft copy of WHC's report, when available.

Review of Open Action Items

Item 4-24-92:1, WHC will endeavor to make arrangements for Ecology to tour the 242-A Evaporator facility on May 21, 1992, before the Unit Managers Meeting. Action: J. Bellomy (WHC). Status: Closed.

Item 4-24-92:2, Provide simplified schematic depicting 242-A Evaporator material balance (assuming typical feed composition and operating parameters). Action: Greg Berlin. Status: Open.
