



Hanford Land Use Planning Information

The U.S. Department of Energy (DOE), Benton County, and the City of Richland created this Information Package to prepare citizens of the Pacific Northwest for public discussions on several key Hanford cleanup policy decisions.

The U.S. Department of Energy, Benton County, and the City of Richland cordially invite you to attend a public information meeting being held on Tuesday, October 1, 1996 at 6:30 p.m. at the Shilo Inn in Richland. This meeting will feature a short presentation on the Draft HRA EIS, which is being prepared by the DOE, as well as presentations on land-use plans being prepared by Benton County and the City of Richland. A question-and-answer period will follow these presentations.

Sixteen days after this public information meeting, a formal public hearing for the Draft HRA EIS and Comprehensive Land Use Plan will be held on Thursday, October 17, 1996 at 6:30 p.m. at the Shilo Inn in Richland. The public is invited to make formal comments at this hearing. Public comment will assist the DOE, Benton County, and the City of Richland in establishing future land-use options for the Hanford Site.

Additional public forums are being scheduled in Washington and Oregon, or will be provided upon request.
