
COMPLETION OF HANFORD FEDERAL FACILITY AGREEMENT AND
CONSENT ORDER (TRI-PARTY AGREEMENT) MILESTONE M-45-54, "SUBMIT
TO ECOLOGY FOR REVIEW AND APPROVAL AS AN AGREEMENT PRIMARY
DOCUMENT A SITE-SPECIFIC SST WMA PHASE 1 RFI/CMS WORK PLAN
ADDENDA FOR WMAS T AND TX-TY"

This letter completes Tri-Party Agreement Milestone M-45-54. The Work Plan provides the Site-specific Single-Shell Tank (SST) Waste Management Area (WMA) Resource Conservation and Recovery Act of 1976 Facility Investigation/Corrective Measures Study (RFI/CMS) Work Plan addenda for WMAs T and TX-TY (Attachment). The Phase 1 RFI/CMS Work Plan for SST WMAs (DOE/RL-99-36), submitted in August 1999, provides the overall framework under which this Site-specific Work Plan was prepared.

The U.S. Department of Energy, Office of River Protection (ORP) requests that the State of Washington Department of Ecology (Ecology) exercise a 30-day review period for this Work Plan and provide ORP with comments by April 30, 2001. ORP proposes to meet with Ecology for comment resolution by May 11, 2001. This will support the schedule for field implementation of the Work Plan. Ecology's efforts in support of this schedule are appreciated.
