



HANFORD FEDERAL FACILITY AGREEMENT AND CONSENT ORDER (HFFACO) EXTENSION OF STATEMENT OF DISPUTE AT THE INTERAGENCY MANAGEMENT INTEGRATION TEAM (IAMIT) LEVEL ON THE REGULATORS' COMMENT VERSION OF THE 221-U FACILITY REMEDIAL DESIGN/REMEDIAL ACTION (RD/RA) WORK PLAN FROM APRIL 17, 2008, TO MAY 30, 2008

Per HFFACO Article XVI, Resolution of Disputes, Section N, the IAMIT agrees to extend the HFFACO statement of dispute on the regulators' comment version of the 221-U Facility RD/RA Work Plan from April 17, 2008, to May 30, 2008. The extension is required to allow additional time to evaluate and discuss the statement of dispute. The U.S. Department of Energy, Richland Operations Office (RL) invoked the dispute resolution process in RL's letter, 08-AMCP-0127, dated March 3, 2008, and transmitted the statement of dispute in RL's letter, 08-AMCP-0143, dated March 27, 2008. This agreement extends that dispute.
