MISCELLANEOUS UNDERGROUND TANKS

Recently, the U.S. Department of Energy, Richland Operations Office (RL) and its contractor, Westinghouse Hanford Company (WHC), made a comparison of approximately fifty miscellaneous underground tanks in the 200 Area against the list of Operable Units, internal units, and unit types contained in the Hanford Federal Facility Agreement and Consent Order (Tri-Party Agreement), Appendix C. This comparison was made as a part of the ongoing investigation into these miscellaneous tanks. These miscellaneous tanks should not be confused with the 177 large single-shell and double-shell tanks. Of the approximately fifty miscellaneous tanks, four tanks (241-TX-302BR, 241-TX-302-XB, 270-W, 241-Z-8) and two vaults (244-TXR, 231-W-151) are not presently identified in the appendix. The two vaults contain internal tanks: vault 244-TXR contains three tanks, and vault 231-W-151 contains two tanks.

No reason has been discovered for their not being included in the appendix, and RL believes this to be an inadvertent omission. To correct this oversight, and to improve the management and visibility of these tanks, RL recommends that the Tri-Party Agreement, Appendix C, be modified to add these tanks and vaults within their respective Operable Units. Enclosed is a draft Change Control Form C-93-05, which reflects this position and which RL recommends to the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) and the State of Washington Department of Ecology (Ecology) as the vehicle for incorporating these miscellaneous tanks into the Tri-Party Agreement.

Description/Justification of Change: The omission of several underground tanks and vaults from the <i>Hanford Federal Facility Agreement and Consent Order</i> (Tri-Party Agreement), Appendix C was recently discovered. Approval of this change will remedy that inadvertent omission. The list of specific tanks and vaults and the changes necessary to add them to the respective Operable Units in Appendix C are provided on the attached page.		
Impact of Change: The incorporation of these tanks and vaults in the Tri-Party Agreement will assure that they are managed and remediated in accordance with the terms of the agreement. Improved visibility of all these units will be provided to the regulators, to the public, and to the U.S. Department of Energy, Richland Operations Office and its contractors through their incorporation into Appendix C of the agreement. This change will not immediately affect any work plans currently in effect.
