ADDRESSING COMMENTS AND RESCOPING FOR THE 100-HR-1, 100-HR-3, AND 100-DR-1 OPERABLE UNITS

This is in response to your letter of April 30, 1991, concerning submittal of Draft C work plans for the 100-HR-3, 100-HR-1 and 100-DR-1 operable units. As you pointed out, we met with the State of Washington Department of Ecology (Ecology) representatives in Olympia on April 24, 1991, to discuss comment resolution for HR and NR work plans. At that meeting, we agreed to evaluate whether it would be possible to submit Draft C work plans for the 100-HR-3, 100-HR-1 and 100-DR-1 operable units by July 1, 1991. However, these discussions took place before the subsequent agreement between the U.S. Department of Energy, Richland Operations Office (DOE-RL), Ecology and the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) to rescope the work in these operable units.

As you are aware, DOE-RL, Ecology and EPA have tentatively agreed on a change package to the Hanford Federal Facility Agreement and Consent Order to gain efficiencies in the past-practice investigation process. One change is a revision to milestone M-12-00, including the establishment of new interim milestones that call for the submittal of "rescoped" work plans for the 100-HR-3, 100-HR-1 and 100-DR-1 operable units by September 1991. Consequently, we now plan to submit documents in support of this milestone.


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Rescoping activities have already begun for these operable units. Rescoping meetings were held on May 29, 1991, for 100-HR-1, June 7, 1991, for 100-DR-1 and June 18, 1991, for 100-HR-3. Another meeting is planned to rescope ecological investigations for 100-HR-3. However, there is an urgent need to determine how rescoping decisions will be reflected in work plans or how they will otherwise be documented. This is especially important in considering that elements such as a baseline risk assessment and studies of the effect of the Columbia River on the hydrology and contaminant migration within the 100-Area operable units will now be addressed on a 100 Area-wide basis rather than within the workscope of each operable unit. EPA, Ecology and DOE-RL representatives tentatively plan to meet on June 27, 1991, to make decisions on documentation of rescoping efforts.
