- ECO Discussion
 1. Discuss implementation for SAA's in general and any other compliance questions/issues
 - D. Singleton requested to visit the Archive Building at WSCF in the near term.
 - D. Singleton provided further clarification on Ecology's planned visits and how the Unit Manager (L. Fearon) would want to visit the WSCF Facility more frequently.
 - L. Fearon requested information on WSCF's TOC Procedure (LA-344-406) and how this correlated with CHPRC's groundwater reports. WSCF agreed to assist with correspondence with CHPRC on the subject and is willing to meet with CHPRC to assist with clarification on groundwater indicator parameter exceedance.
 - L. Fearon would like to visit WSCF in the near term. Date to be established.

 2. Per Ecology's specific request, provided by L. Fearon, WSCF agreed to provide confirmation of Groundwater well sample receipt for each specific request.

- Significant impacts
 1. At 3:00 AM on July 10, 2012 WSCF North Laboratory experienced a loss of power which resulted in an unplanned shut down of all ventilation systems. Operations within the Lab were placed in a safe configuration. Per the Air Operating Permit WDOH was notified of this unplanned/non-routine shutdown. The WSCF North Laboratory ventilation was returned to service on 7/15 at 2:00 pm. The ventilation system was brought back on-line and normal operations within the WSCF Lab were allowed to resume. The power outage was caused by an electrical breaker.

 - A few turn-around times were missed.
