Re: Notice of Intent to Operate a Temporary Portable Emission Source at the Waste Treatment and Immobilization Plant (WTP) Concrete Batch Plant.

Permission to operate a 676-horsepower diesel generator at the Hanford Site Waste Treatment Plant (WTP) Concrete Batch Plant as a Temporary Portable Source shall be allowed per Washington Administrative Code (WAC) 173-400-110 (9).


The source will be allowed to operate, at the specified location, for a period of one year, beginning March 18, 2002 and ending March 17, 2003, with total operating time limited to 1600 hours. If it is determined that the generator will be needed for emergency backup power beyond the allowed one year period, the WTP Concrete Batch Plant Approval Order No. DE01NWP-003 will require modification.
